

SAMPLE INTINERARY

1. Guests scheduled to arrive at 6
 - a. DJ set up by 5, begins playing when first guest arrives
 2. While guests mingle, slow/happy hour/ 'feel good' music is being played
 - a. EXAMPLES
 - i. Unchained Melody
 - ii. Brown-eyed Girl
 - iii. Going to the Chapel
 - b. I would make sure that the guests are aware that dinner will be served upon arrival of the wedding party
 3. As wedding party arrives, I make the crowd aware and ask for silence while intro song is being played
 - a. Introduction of wedding party
 4. Wedding party is seated, then the blessing of the food is done
 - a. Guests will be dismissed to the buffet, or food brought as arranged to tables
 - b. Slow songs will be played low key during dinner, as not to mess with conversations being held
 5. Dinner
 6. Introduction of Parents, grandparents, others
 7. Toasts by selected guests
 8. Cake Cutting
 9. Mother / Son Dance
 10. Father/Daughter dance
 11. Everybody joins in dancing
 - a. 3-5 dance songs
 - b. Slow song
 12. Announcement of the garter toss (optional)
 13. Announcement of the bouquet toss
 14. \$ Dance (Garter/Bouquet catchers may dance in stead of this as well)
 15. General Dancing for remainder of the night
 - a. 7 – 10 dance/upbeat songs for every 2 slow songs
- The general dancing sections could also include group songs such as
 1. Cha-Cha slide
 2. Electric slide
 3. Chicken dance
 4. Hokey-Pokey
 5. Margarena
 6. Come on Ride the train
 7. The Booty Call
 8. Beer-Barrel Polka
 9. Rocky-top

Last call and final song – wishing guest a safe trip home
